



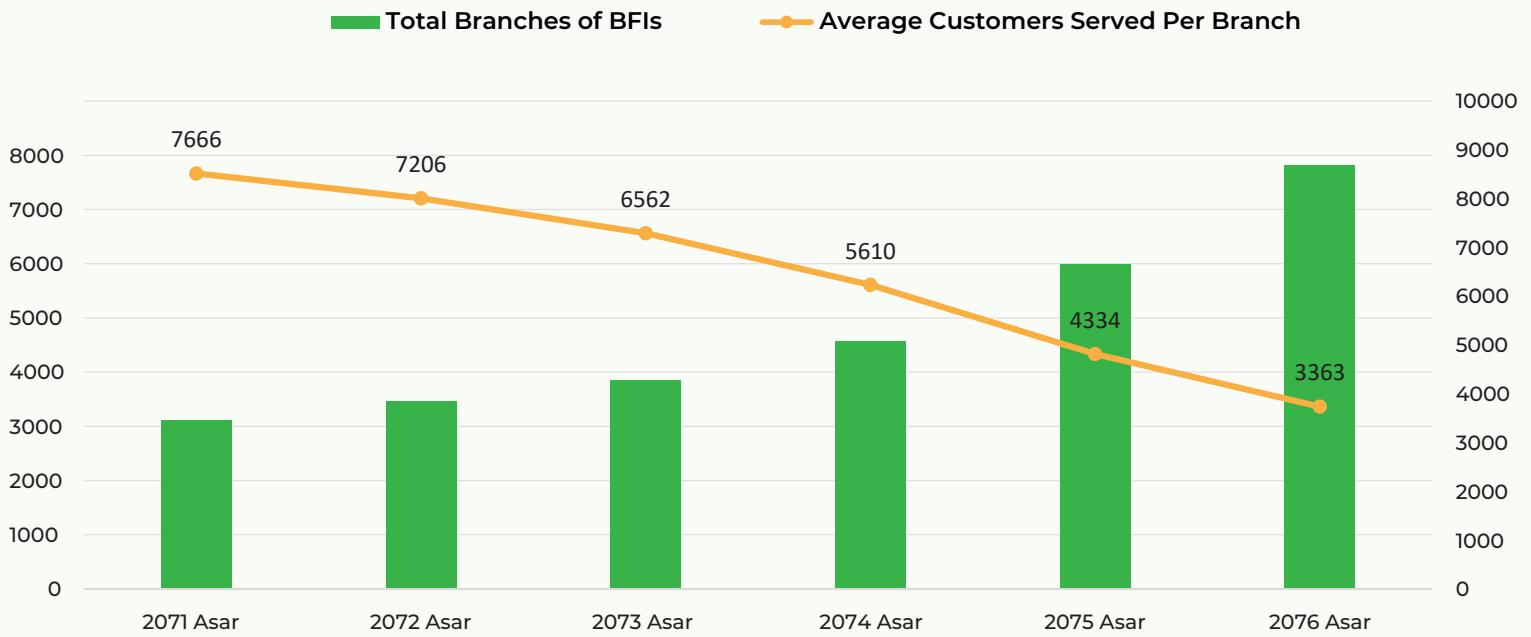

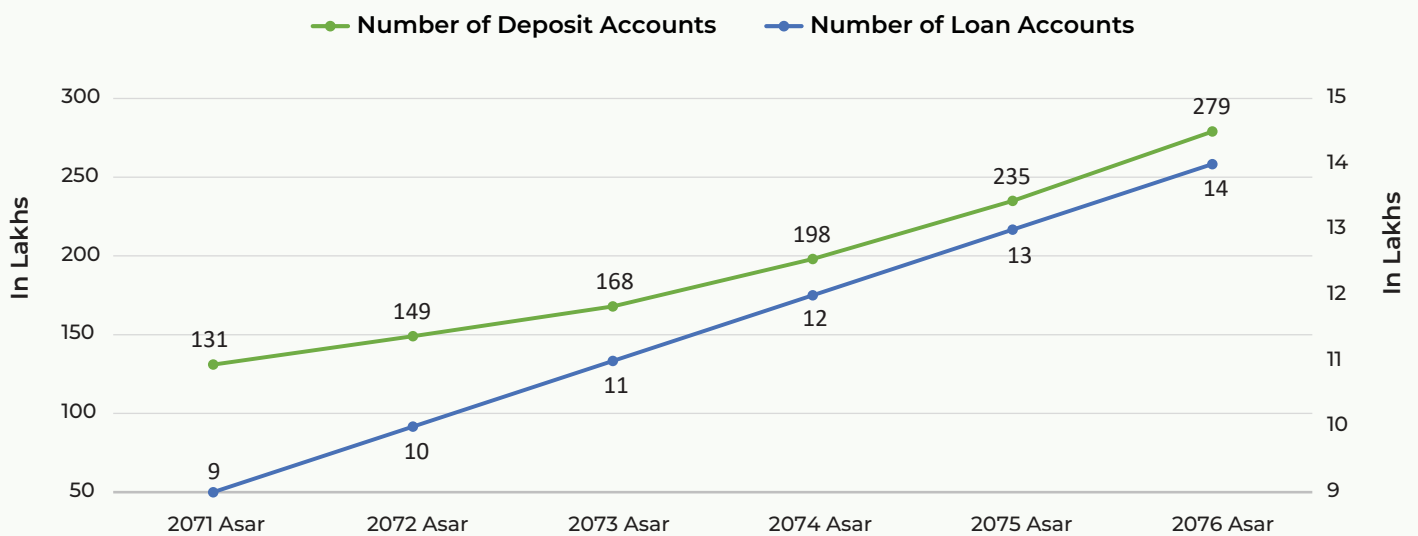


Branches of BFIs and Average Customer Served Per Branch

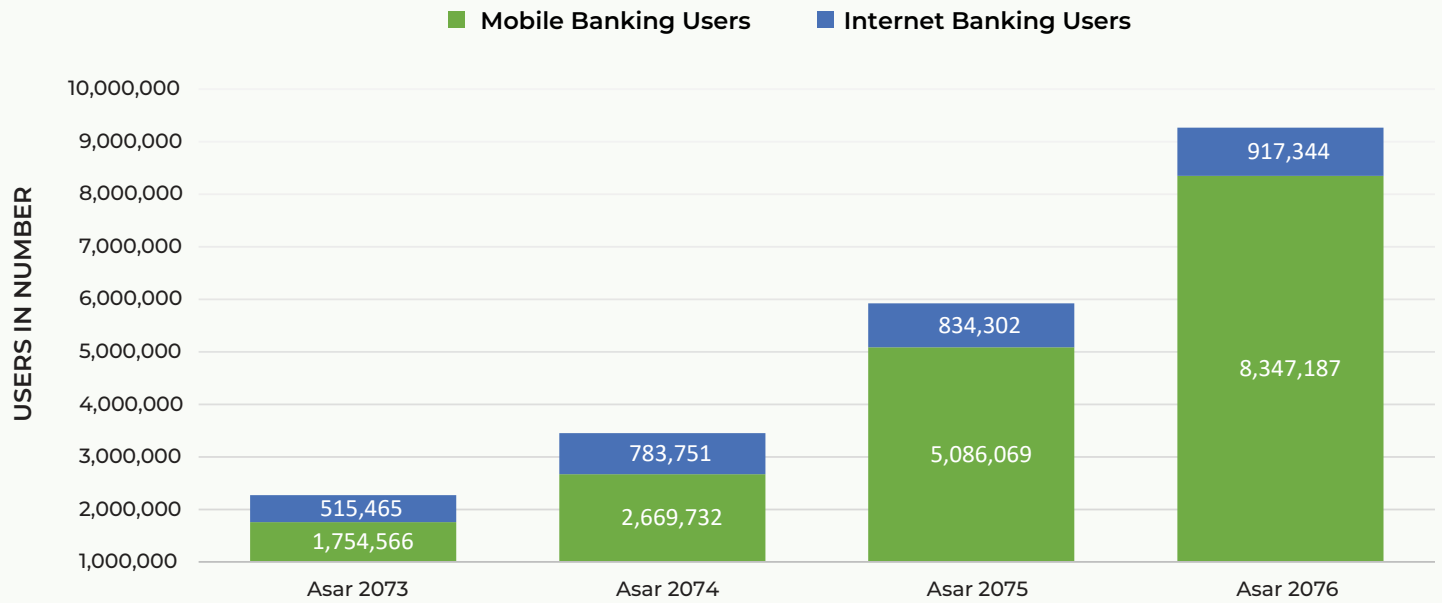
Number of Deposit Accounts and Loan Accounts

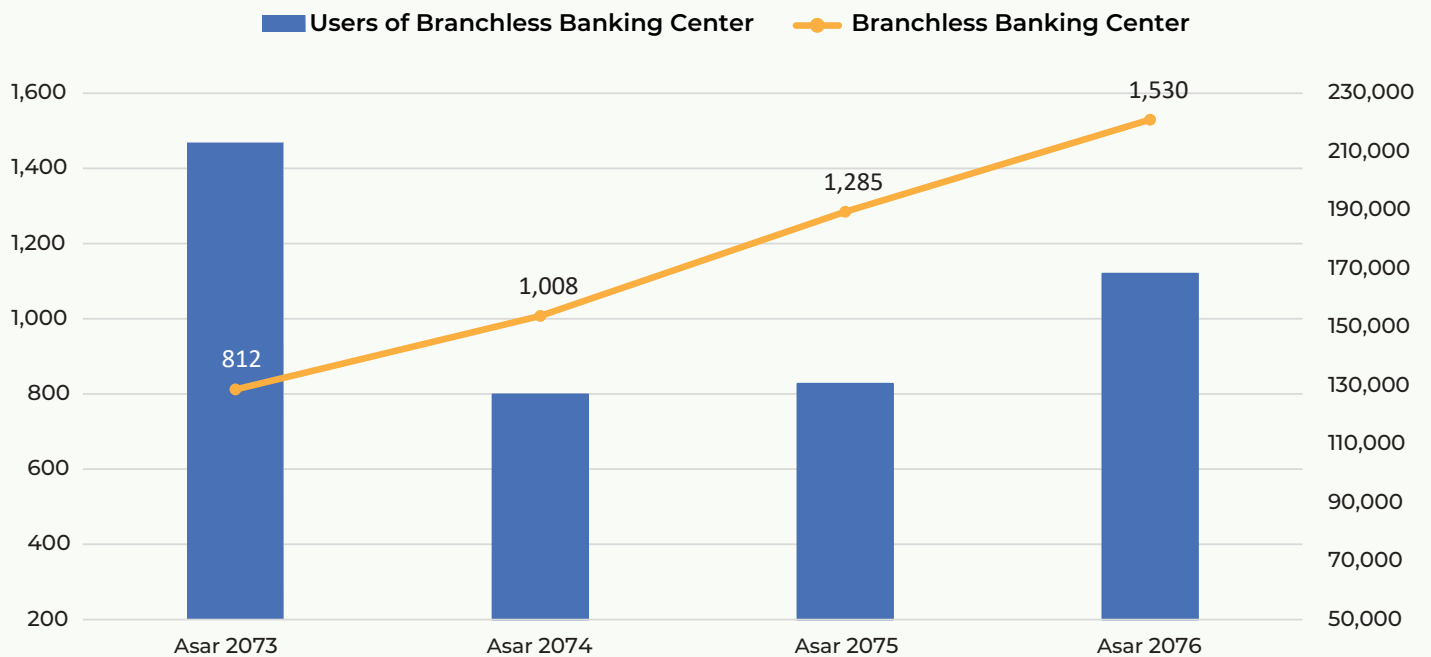


Users of Mobile Banking & Internet Banking

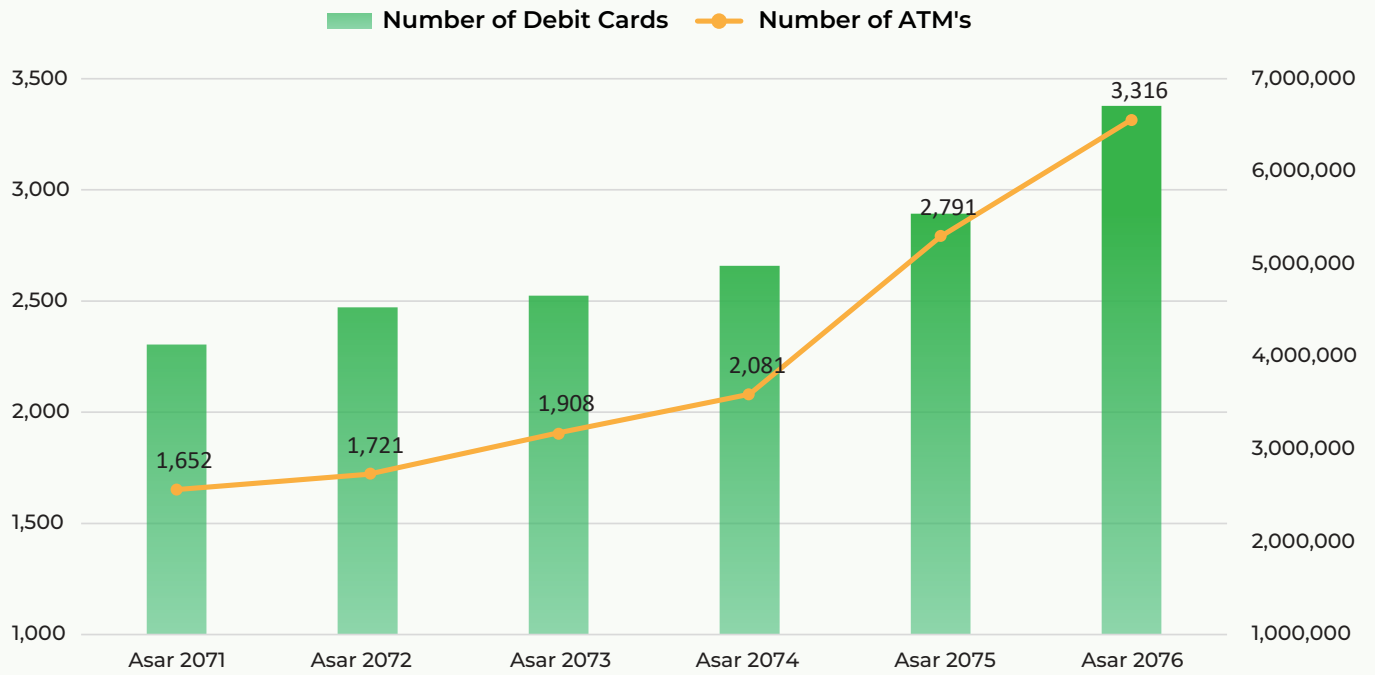
Branchless Banking Centers & Users of Branchless Banking Center

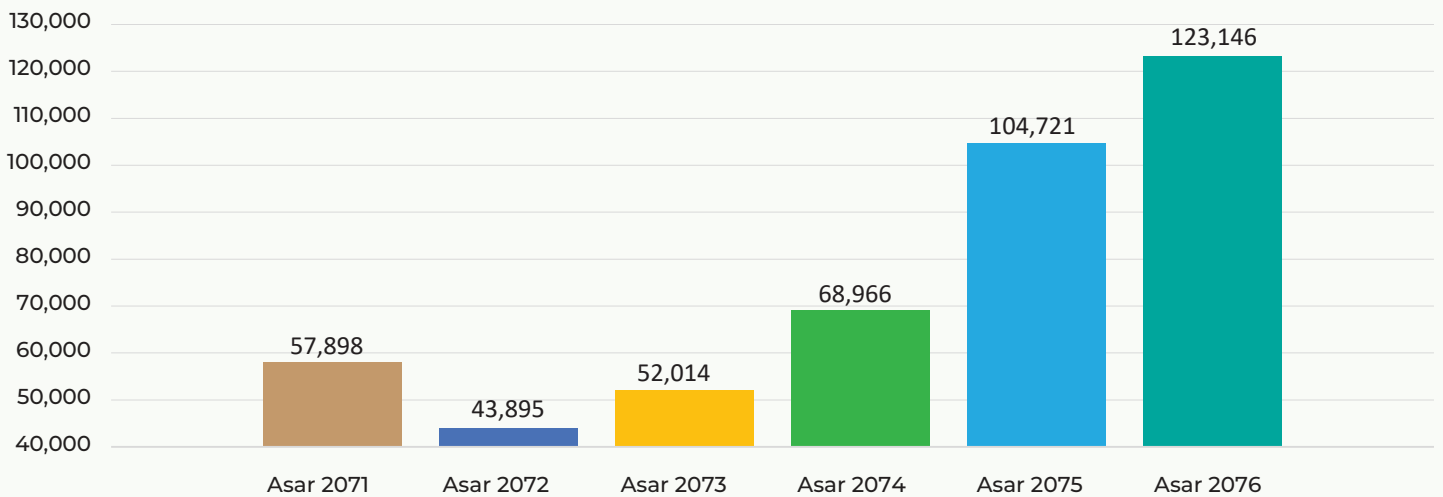


Number of ATMs & Debit Card Users

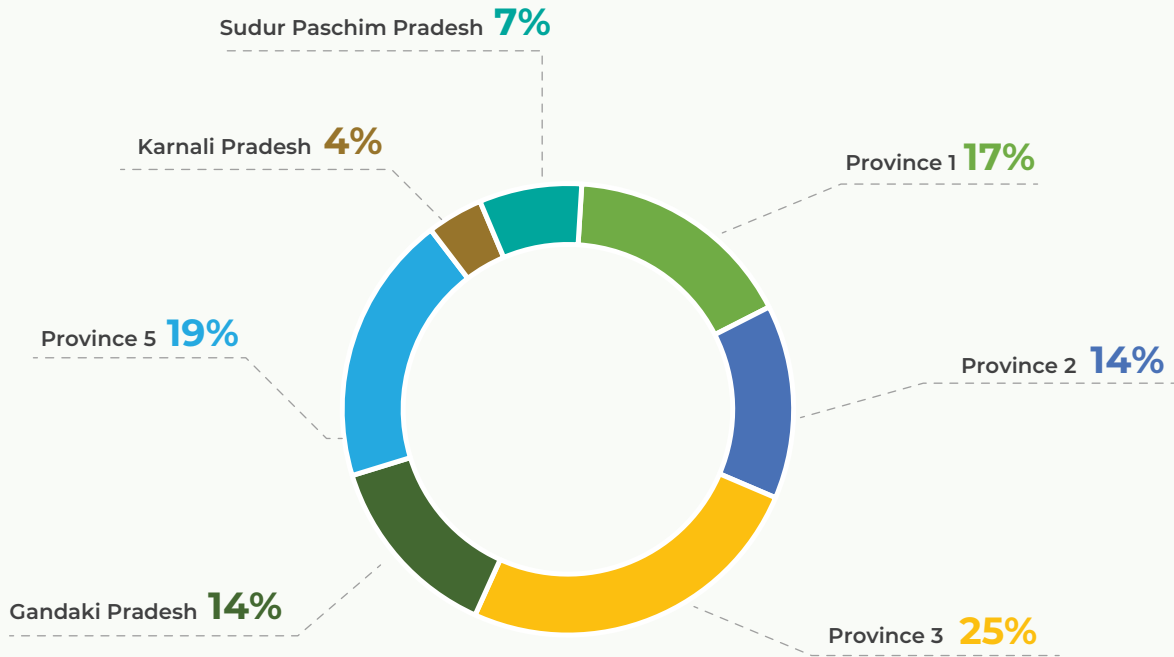
Number of Credit Card Users

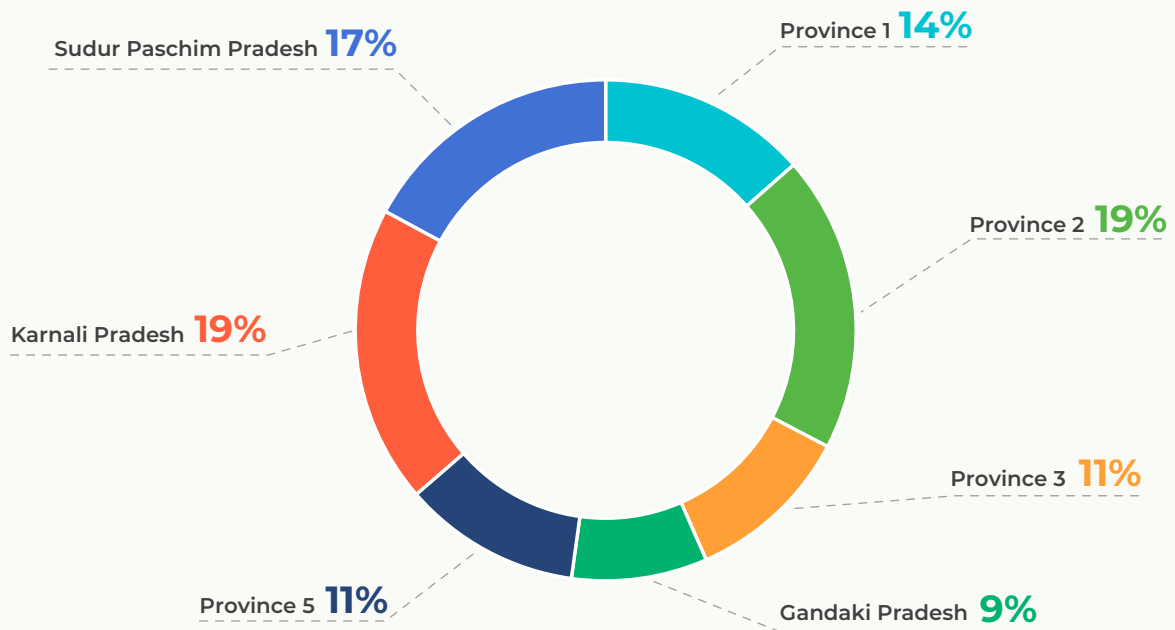


Total Branches of BFIs in 7 Province as of Asar 2076



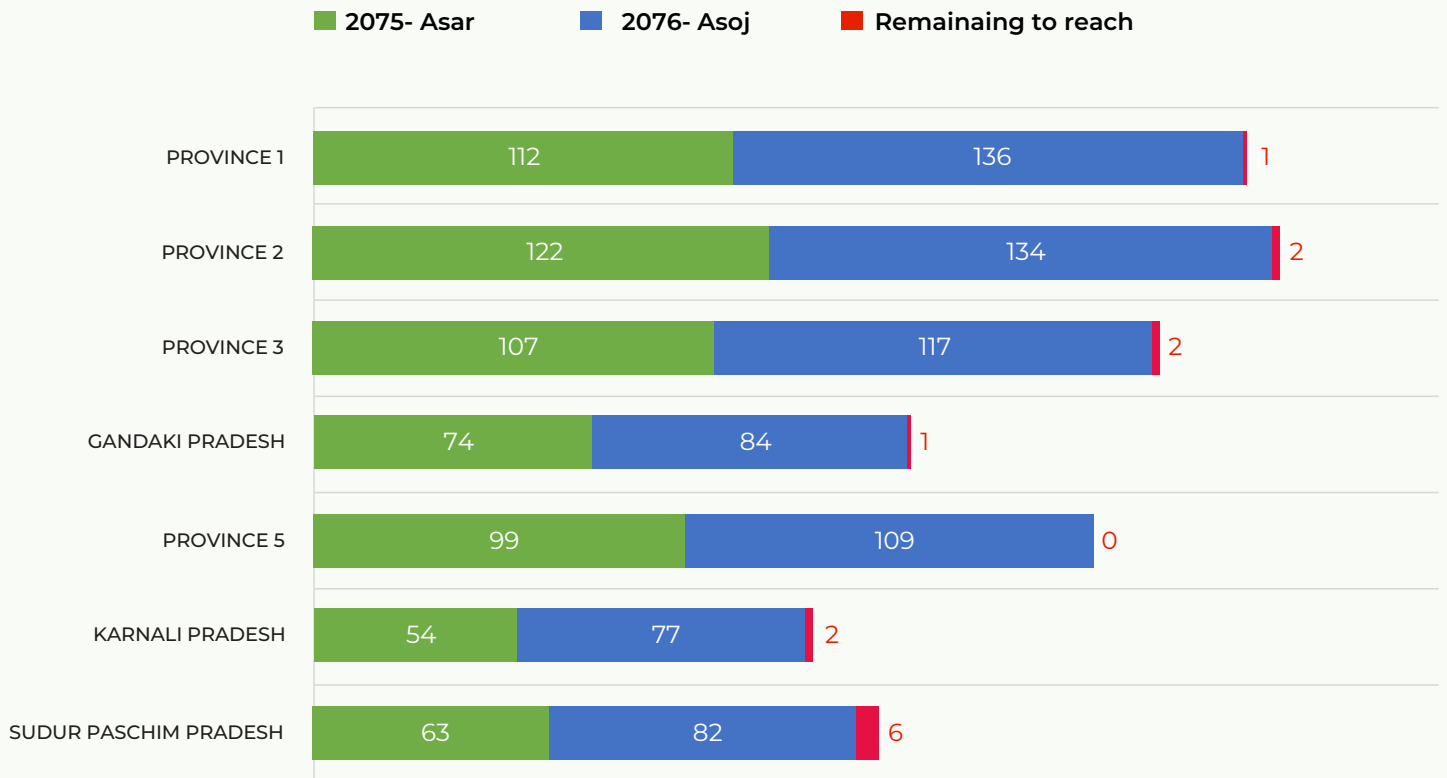

Province wise Population per Branch as of Asar 2076



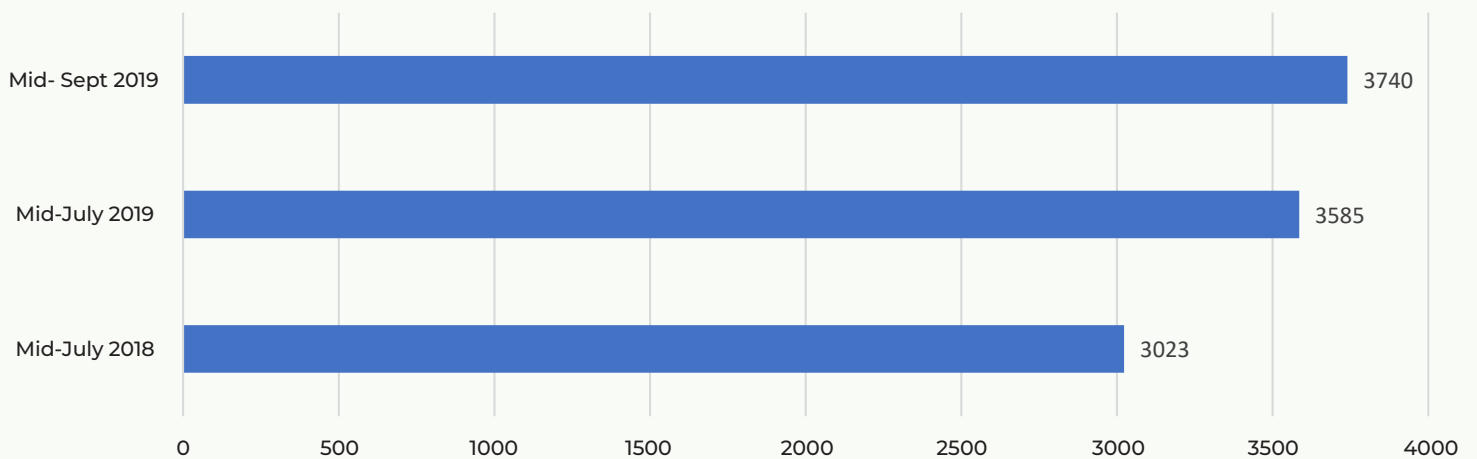
